

Dental Accident

Claim money back, up to set limits, for dental treatment carried out as a result of accidental injury to teeth, caused by direct external impact to the head, including:

- Chipped tooth
- Tooth fractures, including root fractures, enamel fractures, etc
- Tooth knocked loose (subluxation)
- Tooth jammed into socket (intrusion)
- Tooth knocked out (avulsion)

In the case of a dental accident, the quicker you act the more chance you have of saving your teeth





- 1. Pick the tooth up by the crown only (do not touch the root)
- 2. Lick the tooth clean if it is dirty, or rinse it in water
- 3. Stick the tooth back in position (adult teeth only)

If it's not possible to put the tooth back in, put it in milk and go straight to a dentist.
